To join in offline - on your own or with your family or group

- Overleaf, you'll find the daily introductory prayer and a numbered list of priests and parishes for the Bromley Deanery.
- So that you are praying for the same priests and parishes on the same days as everyone taking part in the Bromley Deanery, start (or re-start) from no. 1 on the list on one of the "day ones" listed overleaf.
- Work day-by-day down the list (no. 1 on day one, no. 2 on day two, etc, and back to no. 1 the day after you get to the end of the list).
- Each day, pray the prayer and at least 1 Rosary decade from the day's Mysteries (Glorious - Sun and Wed; Joyful - Mon and Sat; Sorrowful - Tue and Fri; Luminous - Thu) for the listed priests and parishes.

- Open to under-18s only if a parent is also in the Group.

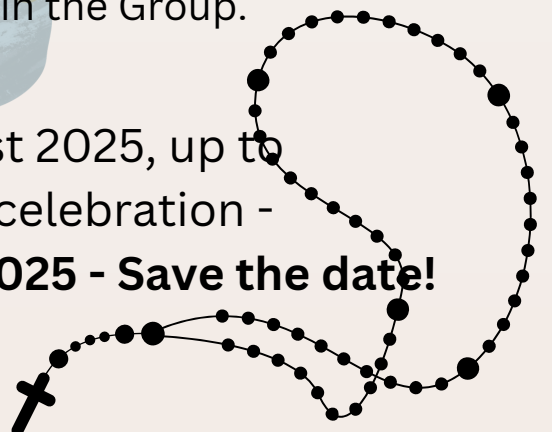


What it's leading up to
