

James Tissot was a French Catholic artist who, having experienced a religious vision late in life, returned to the faith and explored exclusively biblical scenes in his late career. Famously he depicted the life of Christ in a wonderful series of paintings with forensic archaeological detail. This painting, *The Adoration of the Shepherds*, is one of several nativity scenes which are extraordinary in emphasising the vulnerability and humanity of the newborn Christ, the divine light of God incarnate, and His transformative impact upon Mary and the shepherds.

As we reflect upon this work of art, I invite you to give thanks for everything that you have been given by God, every blessing, and to remember that the Word became flesh so that He could suffer as humanity does and so free us from the shackles of sin.

This Christmas let us give thanks to God for the greatest gift of all, Himself.

JUST PRESS PLAY! - THE BIBLE IN A YEAR

Last December I wrote a piece for the newsletter, inviting fellow parishioners to consider a new year's resolution to become more familiar with the bible. I mentioned in particular the Bible in a Year podcast, led by Fr Mike Schmitz, a youngish and very enthusiastic American Catholic priest. Over 365 days he reads the entire 73 books of the Catholic bible with a prayer and a reflection on how the scripture relates to our lives today. The podcast varies from 15 to 25 minutes a day. This daily routine has had such a massive impact on my life of faith that I wanted to share my experience. I set up and lead a group of around 12 parishioners who meet fortnightly to discuss how what we have heard has 'spoken' to us. We discuss scripture and faith together and encourage and support each other. We are not all at the same point in the bible reading plan, some are almost 'finished', others are taking it more slowly - it doesn't matter.

Fr Mike is keen to emphasise 'transformation – not information transfer' and this has resonated strongly with me and the others in the group.

What we read from God's word has truly helped me to live out my faith and has given me a daily focus, rooted in God's word and the teaching of the Catholic Church.

The podcast is available free on Hallow app, Ascension app or on YouTube. You can also use the QR code on the flyers located on the notice board by the side entrance of the church.

My invitation to you is – just give the **Bible in a Year** a try. You have nothing to lose and so much to gain. 
We want to thank you so much for your generous donations of food to our Christmas Appeal.
